 - The registration form and payment will be accepted online, cash, and check.- (information regarding online payments will be released soon)
 - The deadline for entry is: Tuesday, FEB. 6, 2024.
 - Fees are \$20.00 per student; \$10.00 per ensemble participant
 - A late fee to \$5.00 per student will be charged if the registration deadline is not met.
 - All fees are non-refundable.

 - Please make sure to fill out 1 student form per student (ensembles may be filled out as a single form)
 - Please fill out 1 teacher form per teacher
- Eligibility:
 - Individual students or members of small ensembles who are enrolled in private lessons or have regular coaching with their school orchestra, band or choral director. Teachers do not need to be GMTA members
 - Age limit: Age 5 through Adult

Additional Information:

- Sheet music:
 - Participants must bring their own sheet music with measures numbered
 - Music must be legally acquired
 - Music is to be memorized except in the case of ensembles
 - Keyboard Ensembles must provide original copies for both the judge and for their own use
- Judging:
 - Judges' results are final
 - Judging may not be interrupted
- Collaborative Pianists:
 - Non-keyboard participants seeking collaborative pianists for the Festival may contact the Festival Chairperson if they are unable to make arrangements themselves
 - Requests regarding assistance finding collaborative pianists must be made before the registration date
 - Students are responsible for paying their collaborative pianist
